A Note about our School

Ahlul-Bayt Islamic School a Canadian not-for-profit institution that is open to everyone, Canadian citizens and internationals residing in Canada under any legal status.

Admission for Junior Kindergarten (JK) & Senior Kindergarten (SK)

Age & Maturity Requirement

- Students eligible for the JK program must be four (4) years of age on or before December 31.
- Students eligible for the SK program must be five (5) years of age on or before December 31.
- Student must be toilet trained and have the ability to understand and follow simple instructions.

Process

- Parents need to complete one enrollment application forms per student. This form is available from the office and on the school's website.
- Student must complete an informal interview with the principal.
For international students: This interview can be done upon arrival to Canada.

Documents

- Proof of birth date for their child. A copy will be kept in the student's Ontario Student Record file. Acceptable documents are: Birth certificate, Birth registration form, Citizenship certificate, Passport, or any national or provincial identification document or card.
- Updated Immunization Form for the child.
- Any records of the student with their current school, daycare, or educational institution.

Admission for All Other Grades (1 - 8)

Process

- Parents need to complete one enrollment application forms per student. This form is available from the office and on the school's website.
- Student must pass an entrance test in English and Math. We can provide some info on this entrance test and preparation. For international students: The test can be done upon arrival to Canada.
- Student must complete an informal interview with the principal.

Documents

- Any records of the student regarding any learning or behavioral difficulties or assessments.
- A copy of the student's most recent report card with their current school or educational institution.
- Updated Immunization Form for the child.

Specialized Instructions

Unfortunately, our school does not have the financial or human resources to support students with Individualized Educational Plans (IEP), or those requiring specialized instructions, special educational services (ESL program), or special modifications and accommodations.
